



Every Generation Festival - 'It's on for young and old'

2010 Subsidy Guidelines

The Every Generation Festival, held every October, focuses on the Over 50s and is a time for older people to share their lives and achievements with people of all ages. To encourage community groups, clubs and organisations to develop events and programs throughout South Australia, a limited number of Every Generation Subsidies up to a maximum of \$250 are made available. The Every Generation Festival Subsidy Scheme is supported by Principal Sponsor the Department of Families and Communities and 2010 Principal Sponsor Aveo Live Well and Networking Clubs in the Community, an initiative of COTA Seniors Voice. Conditions apply - see guidelines below.

Please note that application for subsidy does not necessarily guarantee that approval will be given.

Applications close on Friday, 13th August, 2010.

- 1) Subsidies are available only to registered Every Generation Partners. To register as a Partner, complete the attached Partner Registration Form and return to COTA Seniors Voice. Registration is free.
- 2) The Subsidy must relate to an event registered as an Every Generation Event. Please register the event on the attached Event Registration Form and return to COTA Seniors Voice.
- 3) The Event must be organised by the local community for the local community. The Subsidy must be spent within the local community on events organised specifically for the Every Generation Festival.
- 4) Significant consideration will be given to intergenerational Events, involving people of all ages in your community.
- 5) Groups representing the Indigenous community and those from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds are encouraged to apply.
- 6) Where no local event can be organised, applications of up to \$100 to subsidise transport to regional or central events will be considered.
- 7) Groups, clubs and organisations that have received subsidies in 2008 or 2009 **will not** be eligible for a further subsidy this year.
- 8) Successful recipients of the subsidy will be required to acknowledge the support of Aveo Live Well and Networking Clubs in the Community at their event. **A completed Evaluation Form and Invoice must be returned to COTA Seniors Voice by Monday, 29th November 2010 for the recipients to receive their subsidy.**
- 9) Subsidies will not be allocated to:
 - local government agencies or for
 - capital goods
 - gifts
 - domestic accessories, e.g. tablecloths and serviettes etc.
- 10) Preference will be given to new groups and applications for programs trying out new activities eg intergenerational social events.

Please note:

Subsidies are conditional on COTA Seniors Voice receiving continued funding from the State Government for the Every Generation Festival.

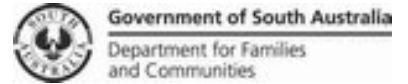
